### Watch out for Japanese Beetles!

These critters are in our neighborhood now. They have red, iridescent wings, and are about <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> inch long. They love to eat roses, Virginia creeper, linden trees, raspberry bushes, and other plants. The females lay eggs in turf grass where they emerge as grubs and live on the roots of the grass. Control methods include traps, hand-picking, and insecticides. You can use pyrethrins, acetamiprid, or azadirachtin when pollinators aren't visiting the plants (dawn and dusk) to kill the beetles. BeetleGONE! is a microbe and won't hurt bees. There are also



products which can be applied to lawns to kill the grubs. (imidacloprid, GrubEx, etc.) For more information go to <u>https://extension.colostate.edu/topic-areas/insects/japanese-beetle-5-601/</u>
