Fall 2024 Lakehurst West “Honker”

A Newsletter from the Lakehurst West Neighborhood Association

UPDATE: We can confirm that the sign located off S Lakehurst Way, was vandalized again. It was cut down and the sign removed. This is the second sign to be damaged requiring us to spend money on replacement. **BACKGROUND:** Over 2 years ago. The LWNA in an attempt to better inform and connect our community voted to spend money on marque signs to allow us to better reach community members who don't read/receive the newsletters (especially the Westfield Neighbors). We reached out with the homeowner who owns the land where the sign is and got permission to upgrade the existing sign with a marque sign. We decided to put the sign on the Kipling fence by the street, but last year this sign was vandalized/destroyed. When the conversation came up in the meeting about replacing it, it was suggested that we move it to a better location for improved visibility by our community. This is why the sign was installed at S Lakehurst Way.

The goal of the sign has always been to be a benefit to our community, not just LWNA membership. We are a voluntary association, and advocate for the neighbors and neighborhood regardless of affiliation with the organization, and the sign has always been a way to better connect and inform our community.

RESPONSE: We are disappointed that this has happened again, because we have always tried to engage and be open to different opinions and responses as an organization. We acknowledge receiving input from community members were appreciative of the sign's new location, but we have also been engaging in communication with anyone with concerns to help come up with solutions that benefit our community as a whole. By destroying the sign, it will cost us limited resources and will hinder improved connection and engagement as a community. Our goal is always to do what's best for the majority of our community members.




We will discuss this at the next LWNA meeting at Bandito's on Oct. 2nd 6-7pm and determine a course of action moving forward. If you have input or comments, please attend the next meeting.

REFLECTION: Over the next few months, we will be going through a tense time for our neighborhood, our community, and our country. LWNA wants to encourage civility and constructive engagement throughout our community. We might not always have the same opinions or beliefs, but we must realize that our differences make us stronger as a community.
